<b>Justification for EICAT assessment</b>	<i>G. rugosa</i> is a predator that preys on both native and non-native species, the decline in population size of endemic Hawaiian insects and snails can not be attributed to the presence of <i>G. rugosa</i> alone (Van Kleeck & Holland 2018). However it is likely that <i>G. rugosa</i> preys on native species and effects the performance of native individuals.

<b>Description of impact</b>	Predation- In Hawai'i, the Japanese wrinkled frog, <i>Glandirana rugosa</i> preys on insects and snails.
