<b>Justification for EICAT assessment</b>	It is not known if this introduced population has had any effects on resident species. No other parrots occur on San Andrés Island (McNish 2003), but it is plausible that Brown-throated Parakeet could compete for food with other large frugivores, such as resident pigeon species (Donegan and Huertas 2011).
