| Justification for EICAT assessment | The Tropical Mockinbird occasionally attempts to kill small birds such as Yellow-bellied Seedeaters (<i>Sporophila nigricollis</i>) and feeds on lizards and a variety of insects such as spiders, grasshoppers and beetles. There is no evidence that this has caused a decline of population of these species (Morton et al. 2004, Danielle B. 2014). |

| Countries of most severe impact | Republic of Trinidad and Tobago; Republic of Panama |
| Description of impact | The Tropical Mockinbird feeds on small vertebrates and invertebrates in Panama and Trinidad and Tobago. They attack Yellow-bellied Seedeaters, but the severity of impact is unknown at present. |
