Justification for EICAT assessment	The Blue-crowned Parakeets foraged together, often calling loudly, particularly just before taking flight. Their preferred food items were similar to those of Rose-ringed Parakeets and included, for example, tree buds, shoots and blossom. Blue-crowned Parakeets in the Bromely area have also been observed feeding on peanuts, sunflower seeds and commercial seed mix in nearby gardens.
