<b>Justification for EICAT assessment</b>	The Mitred Parakeet has been observed to displace Great Frigatebirds ( <i>Fregata minor</i> ) from roosting areas and to compete with shearwaters ( <i>Puffinus</i> spp) and petrels ( <i>Pterodroma</i> spp.) for nesting sites in cliff-side burrows. There is no evidence that this has affected the performance of these species (MISC 2002).
